BHDDH Methodology for Setting Rates Effective July 1, 2011

- 1. BHDDH utilized multiple sources to develop its new rates effective July 1, 2011:
 - --a provider survey was administered in December 2010 to obtain information on costs such as staff wages, fringe benefits, program costs, administrative costs, and the amount of time spent to deliver services. BHDDH surveyed all private agencies and achieved a 95% response rate.
 - --The information used from this survey was reviewed with a Rates Workgroup that met over the course of 16 meetings. The Work Group was comprised of BHDDH staff and providers.
 - --External sources were researched for staff wages and fringe benefits. Data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics on staff hourly wages was compared against survey results. Data from the Medical Expenditure Panel Survey was compared to survey results on health insurance take up rates and premiums paid by employers.
 - --Provider agencies are required to submit a BHDDH-specific cost report. Results from the cost reports for FY 2009 were compared against survey results.
- 2. BHDDH established a "benchmark" rate which was the rate that we would like to pay if there was a stronger economic climate. Even in this case, BHDDH selected the median wages from the Bureau of Labor Statistics to develop the benchmark rates.
- 3. Due to limited funding, BHDDH then developed a "Proposed Rate" for each service. In most cases, this rate is about 14% below the Benchmark rate. This was done by assuming wages at the Bureau of Labor Statistics 25th percentile instead of the 50th percentile.
- 4. Even when our Proposed Rates were modeled agains the FY 12 budget, we found it unaffordable. Therefore, we developed what we are calling the "Adopted Rate" for each service. In most cases, this is about 17-19% below the Benchmark rate. This was done by reducing the assumption in the model for fringe benefits. For some services, we also lowered the assumptions for other agency costs such as program expenses and transportation.
- 5. We did not reduce our assumptions for the level of staffing hours required to serve individuals in either the Proposed Rates or the Adopted Rates. In other words, we are forcing the providers to stretch their dollars without compromising the level of services to individuals.
- 6. In every model for Benchmark, Proposed and Adopted rates, we assumed 10% Administrative costs. This is below the average reported by providers on the survey (12.7%) and below the average on the latest cost reports (10.5%).
- 7. We purposefully did not just do an across-the-board cut against every Benchmark rate. We limited the reduction for Shared Living Arrangements since this is the most cost-effective method to provide 24 hour supports to individuals that need it. We also ensured that the payment to host families remained the same as last year in order to encourage this service.
